

COVID-19 DECISION TREE FOR RETURN TO SCHOOL

Have you experienced any COVID-19 signs and symptoms?
(1 High Risk or 2 Low Risk Symptoms)

High Risk Symptoms

- Fever > 100.4°F (38°C)
- New cough
- Shortness of breath / Difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell

Low Risk Symptoms

- Sore throat
- Headache
- Diarrhea / Nausea / Vomiting
- New nasal congestion / Stuffy or Runny nose (not allergy-related)
- Fatigue / Muscle or body aches

If you have **only 1 low risk symptom**, stay home until symptom resolves. If other symptoms develop, follow the chart below.

IF YES, DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL.

Notify the Reception of the illness. If you are at school, you will be sent home.

DID YOU GET TESTED FOR COVID-19?

YES

Negative Result + No known COVID- 19 contact = Notify Reception

- Stay home until no fever, diarrhea & vomiting for a full 24 hours without use of medication.
- Submit proof of negative PCR test to school.

Negative Result + Known COVID-19 contact = Notify Reception

No Quarantine needed

- Stay home until no fever, diarrhea & vomiting for a full 24 hours without use of medication.
- You may return to school with proof of negative PCR test.
- Continue wearing a mask indoors and in public any time you are around others, until Day 10.

Positive Result = Notify Reception

- Stay home for 5 days. If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.
- If your symptoms have resolved, you may return to school on Day 6.
- Continue to wear a mask indoors and in public around others, until Day 10.

COVID-19 DECISION TREE FOR RETURN TO SCHOOL

DID YOU GET TESTED FOR COVID-19?

NO

Notify Reception

- Stay home until at least 7 days have passed since symptom onset
- No fever, diarrhea & vomiting for a full 24 hours without use of medication
- Other symptoms have improved.

If you have an ongoing medical condition, please contact a member of the KISC Leadership Team for case review.

FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF WHO ARE ASYMPTOMATIC, BUT TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19.

DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL.

Notify Reception

- Stay home for at least 5 days from the first positive viral test.
- You may return to school on Day 6.
- Continue to wear a mask indoors and in public around others, until Day 10.
- If you go on to develop symptoms, follow the advice on page 1.
